- 1. Entrants shall be amateurs who are members of clubs of the association or of clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by the Association or of clubs affiliated with Golf Australia. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 2. The Competition shall be played in accordance with the rules of Golf as adopted by the royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final, provided however, that the committee, if in doubt, shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the council of Golf Australia whose decision shall then be final.
- 3. Players must be prepared to play when called upon by the Committee.
- 4. In every event competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the committee may arrange.
- 5. In the event of a tie in a scratch event, a result will be determined by a sudden death play-off, or such other method as may be introduced by the Tournament Committee. Ties in Handicap events shall be decided using the count-back system as stipulated by Golf Australia.
- 6. The Committee may in the event of bad weather, or any other reason, either cancel or shorten any contest or move to another day.
- 7. Rule 6-7 (Pace of play) will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties may be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay.
- 8. ALL players must check in on arrival at club house before play
- 9. Maximum handicap of 36 will apply to men's events
- 10.Maximum handicap of 45 will apply to Women's events.
- 11.Maximum handicap for mixed events: Men 36, Women 45.
- 12.Distance measuring devices are permitted.
- 13.Golflink numbers MUST be supplied.
